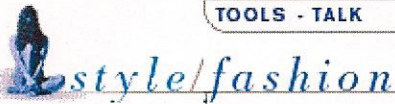

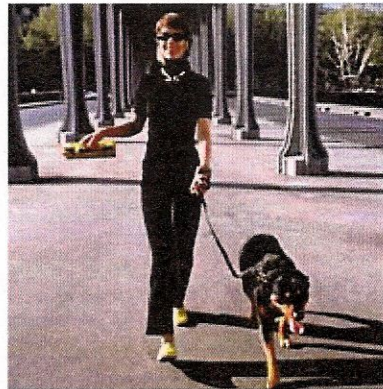
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La Parisienne—How Does She Do It?

7. Adornment: La Parisienne considers herself naked without perfume, makeup and a manicure—judiciously applied, for highlighting and camouflaging her game at will.

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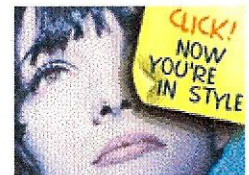


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8. Uniqueness: La Parisienne has something distinctively hers—an unusual piece of jewelry, for example, or a silk scarf tied in her own inimitable way.
